INFORMATION FROM THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE

Late arrivals:

If you arrive to school late, or return from an appointment for which you had an early dismissal, ALWAYS check in at the attendance office even if it's during lunch or a passing period.

Early dismissals:

If you know you'll be leaving early for an appointment, please have your parent/guardian call the attendance office prior to school starting (you can pick up your pass on your way to class), or have them send a note with you. Bring the note to the attendance office before school to get a "Special Excuse" pass to leave at the time specified. Please note: if your parent/guardian comes into the school to dismiss you due to a last minute appointment, they will need to allow 15 to 20 minutes for you to be released, especially if you're in PE or if they come in during the "intervention period" when it may be difficult to locate you.

If you are feeling ill while you are in the classroom, get a pass from your teacher to go see the nurse. The nurse will then contact your parents arranging for your dismissal. Using your phone while in class to call or text your parents will put you in jeopardy of losing that phone!!

Absence clearance:

Please remember that all absences need to be cleared by your parent/guardian as soon as possible, preferably the day of the absence. They may call the school at 916-726-1400 or a note from your doctor or parent/guardian may also be sent with you upon your return to school.
